**NOTES:** Kids Against Hunger® has nearly 100 Satellites across the US and Canada and is expanding on a consistent basis. At the same time, domestic need continues to increase. Accumulatively, the total number of meals staying in the US doubled from 2010 to 2011 even while overall meals packaged declined. *\*In Lincoln, our local meals appear to decline substantially this is due to a large amount of meals being distributed locally at the end of 2010 and beginning of 2012 which leaves 2011 looking a bit short!* Our goal is to meet local demands first which is why we're packaging in low-income schools; allowing the students to taste the food so they know it's better than it looks; then making that food available to them for the asking!
